## Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) Reimbursement Worksheet

Federal funds are available in the form of per meal reimbursement for SFSP operating and administrative costs and cash-in-lieu of commodities payments. Reimbursement is based on meals served times the appropriate rate regardless of actual operating costs, administrative costs or administrative budget. Column (d) represents a combined operating/administrative rate. Reimbursement varies if sponsors' sites are rural or non-rural, or if they have self-preparation or vended meals. Current reimbursement rates are available at <a href="https://cnw.ksde.gov/">https://cnw.ksde.gov/</a>, Key Links, Reimbursement Rates. Cash-in-lieu of commodities payments at the rate of 1-1/2 cents (.015) per meal are paid to those sponsors that prepare their own meals or enter into an agreement with a school food authority for the preparation of meals.
