



KSDE E-Rate Guidance

Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)

School districts must determine their E-rate discount based on their district free/reduced percentage (as opposed to using the percentage for each individual school). For CEP schools, they will use the number of Identified Students and multiply it by the federal CEP multiplier (currently 1.6). This number is then added to the district total of free/reduced students and then divided by the total number of students enrolled in the district.

Example:

District A	Enrollment	Identified Students	Identified Students x 1.6	# of Free/Reduced Students
School 1 (CEP School)	180	100	160	N/A
School 2 (non-CEP School)	100	N/A	N/A	30

The E-Rate calculation is $190/280 = 67.86\%$.
